Introduction 简介

In this project you will create an MLA reference guide that shows some of the most important MLA document requirements. Keep in mind that MLA has many different rules and regulations, and new regulations are being added every year. Since it will not be possible for us to review every rule in MLA in this course, we will focus on some of the biggest and most important rules.

NOTE: Keep in mind that since there are many regulations in MLA you should always check with your teacher about any specific requirements they have for their projects.

The key aspects that we will focus on are: Formatting a document correctly using project "headers", "leaders", "titles", "body paragraphs", and "footers".

We will also review regulations relating to the proper use of information that has been found during the research stages of your project. This will include reviewing the differences between "COPYING", which is not allowed, "quoting", and "paraphrasing" information in your project.

NOTE: DO NOT PLAGIARIZE. Although you need to support your projects with creditable facts, there is a difference between stealing someone else's ideas, and using these ideas to support your own ideas in your project.

Think about this: What is the difference between including a "**short quote**", and an "**extended excerpt**" or "**passage**" in your project? How might we be required to format these differently in a document using MLA regulations?

Project Instructions 项目说明

-Changed the document type, or page layout to the "A4" paper size.

-Include a "header" with your last name and auto page number.

> Project Title: MLA Reference Sheet (Centered 12pt. Arial or Times New Roman)

The body of your project should be doubled space so that the teacher has space to write comments about your work in-between the lines of your essay. You should only use a font size of 12pt. and use an easy to read font such as "Arial" or "Times New Roman". Your page margins for a standard essay is 1 inch from the left and right edges of the paper.

You also need to cite all of your research material. You can give credit to the author by including their name in brackets at the end of the sentence like this (Author's last name). This is called an <u>in-document citation</u>. There should also be a complete citation at the end of your essay on the <u>Works Cited</u> page for every author or publication you cited in your essay or report. You can also cite a source by stating according to (the name of the individual or organization) followed by the relevant facts.

If you include an extended excerpt or "quote" from an author that is more than 50 words, or more than 2 lines, you must indent the text 1 full inch from the left page margin and include the authors name in brackets at the end of the excerpt or quote (Author's name).

Works Cited:

(The last page of your essay should include all your sources)

Your citations should be in alphabetical order. Make sure you include all the important information and use the correct citation format for either print, internet, or other. A proper formatted citation has a <u>hanging indent</u> which looks like the examples below.

(The authors last name, first initial). (*The Title of the Book*). (The City The Book Was Published in): (The company that published the book), (The year the book was published). Print.

(The authors last name, first initial). <u>(The name of website)</u>. (The sponsoring organization). (The date you accessed or went to the website) <URL (the complete web site address)>.

Academic Paper Sentence Starters:

The (author) states that (what the author said). According to (organization's name) (relevant fact). According to (person's name) (what makes them a reliable source) (relevant fact). (Authors name) quotes (original source) in their recent article (title) that (details). On (date) (person's name) said "(what they said)".
