Level 1: Beginner

(few words, many hesitations, no ability to extend conversation)

- What's your name?
- Where are you from?
- What time is it?

Level 2: Low Intermediate

(simple answers, little conversation, many errors)

- How long have you lived in here?
- What did you do yesterday?
- Do you have a hobby? What is it?

Level 3: Intermediate High

(some elaboration, can converse with errors and some hesitations)

- Have you ever taken the TOEFL test? What was your score?
- Can you tell me what some of the differences are between here and where you are from?
- What's your favourite season of the year? Why? Can you describe the weather?

Level 4: Advanced

(lots of elaboration & interaction, errors don't hinder communication)

- What's the most memorable vacation you've ever had? Can you tell me more about it?
- Can you describe something that was on the news in your country? What do you think about it?
- What do you want to be doing in five years? Do you think it's possible?
- If I were to go to your your home (country / city) as a tourist, what should I see?

Extended Intermediate Interview Questions

1 Personal information and family

- What have been the best moments of your life so far?
- Could you tell me about your family?
- Would you rather be an only child or would you like to have brothers and sisters?
- How often do you see your relatives? On what occasions do you see them?
- Could you tell me about your favourite relative?
- What kind of family would you like to have in the future?
- How do you share housework in your family?
- Do you think children should help with the housework? Why and how? / Why not?
- What are some of the things that your family usually do together?
- How are weekdays different from weekends in your family's life?
- What are your plans for the future?

2. Personal interactions and Society

- What are you like as a person?
- Could you tell me about your best friend?
- What is important about a friend for you?
- How do you usually celebrate your birthday?
- What kind of clothes do you like to wear? Why do you like to wear this style of clothing?
- Do you try to follow the latest fashion? Why or why not?
- Could you tell me about the shopping habits in your family?

3. Our Environment

- Could you describe the area where you live?
- Would you rather live in a big city or in the country? Why would you want to live there?
- Could you describe your (house / apartment) and the rooms in it?
- Could you describe the (home / apartment) that you would like to have in the future?

- What does your family do anything to protect the environment? What do you do yourself to protect the environment?
- What kind of weather do you like (the most / the least)? Why?
- Which season of the year do you like (the best / the least)? Why?

4. School

- Why did you choose to study at this school?
- What do you like the most about your (new / old) school?
- What are some of the things you would change about your old school?
- What are your favourite (subjects / lessons) at school? Why do you like this subject?
- Can you talk about your favourite teacher?
- How can you use your English in the future?
- How do you think you can learn English better? What has worked for you? Why has this helped you learn English in the past?
- What do you like most about learning English?

5. Work

- Could you tell me about a job you would like to have in the future?
- Would you like to be self-employed or work for someone else? Why?
- Have you ever had a summer job? If yes: Could you tell me about it? / If no: Would you like to have one this summer?

6. Life-style

- Describe what you do during an ordinary school day?
- How are your week-days different from weekends and holidays?
- Is your lifestyle healthy? Why or why not? What should you do differently?
- What do you normally have for your (breakfast / lunch / dinner)?
- What does your family usually eat and drink on special occasions (e.g. Christmas, Easter, birthdays)?
- What do you like to eat? Why do you like to eat ____? Is ____ healthy?
- Do you prefer traditional restaurants or fast-food? Why?
